3. Managing and organising bibliographic data and documents (how to create folders, how to delete duplicates, tags, filters...).
4. PDF documents reading and writing
5. Inserting citations and bibliographies in manuscripts using a specific citation style
6. Sharing references and documents with other researchers and colleagues
